Scholarship Information for the 2015-2016 School Year

It is time once again to think about scholarships offered to your eligible child or grandchild through your Local Union No. 31 and the International Brotherhood of Teamsters.

Information and application forms are available for:

- James R. Hoffa Memorial Scholarship (JRHMS) for the son, daughter, or financial dependent of a Teamster Member or qualified retiree who is a member "in good standing"; in their last year of high school and planning to attend an accredited four-year college or university. Deadline March 31, 2015. (\$10,000 and \$1000) In order to verify the information, the submission should be sent to the Local's office one week prior to this deadline.
- James R. Hoffa Essay Contest, a component of the JRHMS Fund for the son, daughter, or financial dependent of an eligible Teamster member; be enrolled full-time in an undergraduate college, university or community college program or a technical or vocational program; be 23 years old or younger by September 30, 2015. Deadline September 30, 2015—the topic will be announced during the summer by the International Brotherhood. Applications may be made in French for Canadian applications. (\$1000)
- International Brotherhood of Teamsters Women's Caucus Scholarship for daughters or sons of an active or retired Teamster member with 12 months of consecutive status; graduating from high school. Please check out www.itwc.info for more information. Deadline May 1, 2015. (2 x \$500)
- Teamsters Local Union No. 31 Scholarship for the eligible children/grandchildren of active members, graduating from high school in 2015. Deadline March 31, 2015. (10 x \$2500)
- Art Price Memorial Scholarship for children/grandchildren of members in good standing of Local Union No. 31. Applicants should be enrolled in grade 12 or in a post-secondary institution (college/university/trade school), 23 years or younger. Deadline March 31, 2015. (1 x \$2500)

THE JAMES R. HOFFA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

**Application for the 2015 - 2016 Academic Year of the
James R. Hoffa Memorial Scholarship Fund
Application Deadline March 31, 2015**

James R. Hoffa became a Teamsters Member in 1934, served as General President for 14 years, and, in recognition of his tireless service to the union, was honored as General President Emeritus for life. At the November 1999 General Executive Board meeting, then-General Secretary-Treasurer C. Thomas Keegel presented a resolution to establish the James R. Hoffa Memorial Scholarship Fund.

The James R. Hoffa Memorial Scholarship Fund awards scholarships annually to outstanding high school seniors. All applicants must comply with the following eligibility and application criteria.

Each applicant must:

1. Be the son, daughter or financial dependent of a Teamster member (hereafter also referred to as "Teamster Member Relation") who qualifies (or in the case of retirees, has qualified)* as a member in "good standing" in the Teamsters Union per Article X, Section 5 of the International Constitution;
2. Be in his/her last year of high school and may not apply if he/she has already graduated from high school;
3. **Be in the top 15% of his/her high school class;**
4. Plan to submit excellent SAT or ACT scores for evaluation (U.S. only);
5. Plan to attend an accredited four-year college or university. Those who plan to attend non-academic or certificate programs or community college may not apply.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE (USE AS A CHECKLIST)

1. Applicant and Teamster Member Relation completes questions 1-15;
2. Attach your list of activities (**VERY IMPORTANT**);
3. Applicant's guidance counselor (or equivalent high school official) completes the section marked "Academic Record";
4. Forward your completed application (including your list of activities) and your Academic Record to your Teamster Member Relation's Local Union, System Federation or National Division. The Secretary-Treasurer will complete the section marked "Membership Verification" and forward to the Scholarship Fund. The application must be submitted to the Scholarship Fund by March 31, 2015, as evidenced by the postmark. Any applications that have not been sent from a local union office will be returned to the applicant.

It is advised that you check in with your pertinent Local Union, System Federation or National Division to make sure that they have processed your application. If time or geographic constraints will not allow you to provide your materials to the Local Union in time, you may scan your materials and e-mail them to: Scholarship@teamster.org.

Applications without activities list or membership verification will not be processed.

Applications not postmarked by the application deadline of March 31, 2015, will not be processed.

*To qualify as a retired Teamster Member Relation, the Member Relation must demonstrate that he/she was retired from a craft represented by his or Local Union and was a member in "good standing" as per Article X, Section 5 of the International Constitution for 5 years prior to his/her retirement.

**A seasonal employee eligible to vote pursuant to Article XXII, Sec. 4 (c) of the International Constitution, shall also qualify as a Teamster Member Relation.

The James R. Hoffa Memorial Scholarship funds are to be used exclusively for tuition, related fees, room and board. In the event that you should withdraw from school for any reason, the unused balance is to revert to the James R. Hoffa Scholarship Fund. Your Teamster Member Relation must document his or her good standing before the disbursement of any funds by the Scholarship Fund. The membership standing is determined by the Local Union's By-Laws. If the Teamster Member Relation is no longer a member in good standing, the scholarship may be forfeited. By signing this application, the student agrees to allow the International Brotherhood of Teamsters and/or the James R. Hoffa Scholarship Fund to publish all or part of his/her essay in any union or scholarship related publication or electronic format.

Cheryl Johnson ITWC Scholarship Program

The International Teamster Women's Caucus (ITWC) awards two (2) scholarships annually not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500 USD) each to deserving high school seniors based on academics. All applications must comply with the following eligibility and application criteria. Each applicant must:

Application Criteria

- Be the daughter or son of an active or retired Teamster member (parent/guardian) who has at least twelve months of consecutive membership in good standing in the Teamsters Union as of the date of application;
- Be in the last year of high school or GED program and may not apply if already graduated from high school;
- Plan to submit SAT or ACT scores for academic evaluation (does not apply to Canadian applicants);
- Plan to attend an accredited college, university, trade or business school.

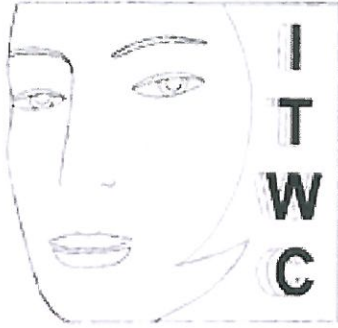
Application Procedure

Attach an essay of 500 to 750 words on the following topic in your own words: "How can Unions motivate our youth and women in particular to become involved in the Union?"

Along with your completed application, additional information will be required. This information is as follows:

- An official high school transcript which includes your class rank and GPA.
- GED Certificate and applicable records or;
- SAT results or ACT results for academic consideration (does not apply to Canadian applicants).
- Proof of Teamster parent/guardian membership status (copy of latest dues receipt or print out from the Local Union).

MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Art Price memorial Scholarship is awarded annually to the child or grandchild of any Teamster member in good standing who exemplifies the encouragement and dedication of past member Art Price. It is awarded annually in the amount of \$2500. Applicants should currently be enrolled in grade 12 or in a post-secondary institution—(college/university/trade school), 23 years old or younger.

The fund was created in 2007 to honour Brother Art "Buttons" Price who was a member of Local 31 from August of 1960, until his passing on April 22, 1993. In his long Teamster career, Brother Price served as Chairman for the shop stewards; he was a committee member on several sets of freight negotiations; and also held the positions of Business Representative and Secretary-Treasurer. He was always available and ready to serve and help his brother and sister members at any time.
